Robust growth likely ahead for Tata Consumer

Brokerages expect margin recovery amid price hikes in key products

Mumbai, 24 April

Price hikes, lower input costs, and double-digit growth are major positives for fast-moving consumer goods (FMCG) major Tata Consumer Products, going into the financial year 2025-26 (FY26). Given that the company has been executing well on the distribution and innovation (new products) fronts, the Street expects it to maintain a robust growth trajectory going ahead.

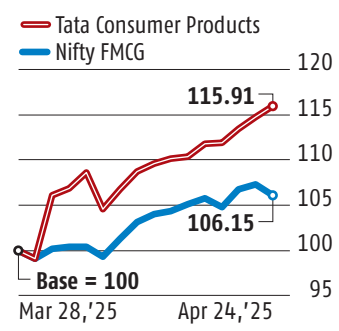
While most brokerages have built in healthy revenue and profit delivery by the company over the next few years, the stock may not see much upside given high valuations. At 83.5 times its FY26 earnings estimates, it is the most expensive stock in the FMCG large capitalisation universe.

The immediate trigger for the stock is the March-quarter result. Given an inline performance and expectations of improvement in margins, the stock was a tad higher in a weak market. Pricing gains for its core businesses led to a 17.3 per cent rise in net sales, which was ahead of the Street's estimates. The gains measured on an organic basis (excluding acquisitions) was up 12 per cent.

The Indian branded business, comprising packaged beverages and foods segments, grew 22 per cent year-on-year (Y-o-Y) while organic growth stood at 13 per cent. The underlying volume growth for the India business was at 5.9 per cent aided by a 2 per cent growth in tea volumes, and about 5 per cent growth of the salt business. Within the food business, salt revenues grew 13 per cent while Tata Sampann registered a 30 per cent growth. Indian branded business comprises the core tea, coffee, and salt brands, and accounts for about two-thirds of the consolidated revenues. The company is focused on

ensuring the upward trajectory of its growth businesses. The segment, which accounted for 28 per cent of India business in FY25, delivered an organic growth of 18 per cent. This was below its target growth rate of 30 per cent due to muted show in the ready-to-drink segment that gained only 2 per cent. The company, however, believes that it will hit the 30 per cent growth target ahead, led by corrective actions in Tata Gluco Plus, and strong momentum across the rest of the portfolio.

While revenue growth was robust, the operating profit of the India business fell 6 per cent due to rising tea costs while at the international level, the metric fell 15 per

cent due to higher coffee prices and expenses. Margins at the gross level were down 420 basis points (bps) while at the operating level they fell 260 bps as compared to the year-ago quarter. Brokerages believe that going ahead, margins in the India business are expected to recover as the company has hiked the prices of salt and tea, and there are early signs of a good tea crop in March and April this year.

Analysts led by Amit Purohit of Elara Securities believe that despite the ongoing economic slowdown, the company's diversified product portfolio and expanding distribution provide good visibility for double-digit sales growth and margin improvement. The brokerage has an "accumulate" rating, with sum of the parts-based target price raised to ₹1,200 (from ₹1,060).

Vishal Punmiya and Manas Rastogi of YES Securities are assigning the company a "premium multiple" as compared to some of its domestic FMCG peers, given an elongated trajectory of strong revenue growth along with margin improvement. While the company is positive on the outlook, they have lowered their recommendation to "add" from "buy" due to limited upside on a one-year forward basis.



Manufacturing funds: Bet on potential gains from global trade shifts

After weeks of tariff-related tensions sparked by the United States, a lull followed the announcement of a 90-day negotiation window by President Donald Trump. While markets reacted with volatility, attention soon turned to the implications for Indian and global manufacturing.

"The global tariff war has brought renewed focus on the manufacturing sector. India has taken a prudent approach by pursuing bilateral trade negotiations rather than escalating tensions, unlike some other nations. This can potentially benefit Indian manufacturers, especially in sectors where we are net exporters to the US, and may even lead to market share gains. However, the final impact will depend on the outcome of the ongoing trade talks," says Lalit Kumar, fund manager, ICICI Prudential Mutual Fund. There are 12 actively man-

aged manufacturing funds, which have total assets under management (AUM) of ₹32,999 crore. Four passive funds also exist; they together have an AUM of ₹473 crore.

Investor sentiment stabilises

Indian investors' concerns about the impact on export-focused manufacturers and thematic manufacturing funds have eased as bilateral talks continue. These funds invest at least 80 per cent of their assets in manufacturing companies

across market capitalisations.

Policy tailwinds

Government programmes such as the Production Linked Incentive (PLI) scheme, export promotion and import substitution, and global companies adopting a China Plus One strategy, are supporting domestic manufacturing.

"Just as the US is looking towards its self-interest, India has an equal incentive to reduce its import dependence and achieve a better balance on its manufacturing trade deficits. The manufacturing theme will still play out with growth in manufacturing likely to be ahead of its growth in gross domestic product, given the government's thrust on stepping up the share of manufacturing in GDP. The domestic story is, therefore, likely to remain strong," says Jitendra Sriram, senior fund manager, Baroda BNP Paribas Mutual Fund.

Thematic risks

Being thematic in nature, manufacturing funds carry

higher risk. "Manufacturing being a thematic bet can be risky and volatile. The manufacturing sector's performance can be affected by various economic and political factors," says Parul Maheshwari, certified financial planner.

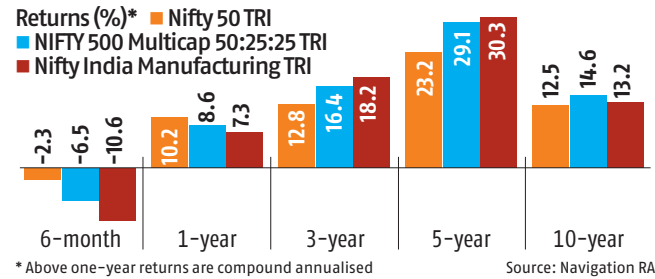
Investors should assess their asset allocation and rebalance it if overexposed to equities in general and thematic funds in particular. "Sectoral/thematic funds, by nature, have a higher risk profile than broad-based funds. If someone has lower risk tolerance, they should evaluate the magnitude and appropriate-ness of exposure to sectoral/thematic funds," says Sriram.

Barring a few exceptions, most manufacturing funds have a short track record.

Long-term commitment essential

Short-term investors seeking quick gains may be disappointed, as the trade-related disputes may take a while to be resolved. Moreover, Indian manufacturing companies are adapting to changing conditions. A long-term horizon is hence crucial. "Investors who have an appetite for risk and are ready to wait for seven years could opt for the systematic investment plan route. They should restrict overall exposure to 5 per cent of the portfolio. Conservative investors or first-time investors should stay away and invest in largecap oriented diversified equity mutual funds only," says Maheshwari.

Paying rent to family and claiming HRA exemption: Key points to remember

What catches the tax department's attention?

- Landlords not declaring rental income in tax returns
- Absence of rent receipts
- Lack of a formal rental agreement
- Rent payments made in cash, or lacking bank transaction proof
- Such discrepancies raise

flags, prompting the department to issue notices seeking clarification to many individuals recently. **Steps to ensure compliance and avoid notices:** RENTAL AGREEMENT: Draft a clear agreement with your relative, specifying rent amount, payment terms and duration. The

document serves as primary evidence of the rental arrangement. **BANK TRANSACTIONS:** Pay rent through banking channels. **LANDLORD'S PAN:** If annual rent exceeds ₹100,000, furnish the landlord's PAN to your employer. **TDS DEDUCTION:** If monthly rent exceeds ₹50,000,

deduct 2 per cent Tax Deducted at Source (TDS) and deposit the amount using Form 26QC. **LANDLORD'S TAX DECLARATION:** Ensure that the relative receiving rent declares it as income in their tax return. This corroborates your HRA claim and demonstrates transparency.
